

SCC Memberships

Scholastic Member: Brevard County students enrolled in grades 9-12. Members in this category must be accompanied or supervised by a designated coach. Access to the facility and boats will be controlled by the coaching staff and other members approved by the Board of Directors. Fees and other requirements will be as established in the annual SCC Parent/Rower Handbook.

Young Adult Member: Age 19-26. SCC alumni rowers and rowers from other high school or collegiate programs approved by the SCC coaching staff and Board of Directors. Members in this category must be accompanied or supervised by a designated coach. Access to the facility, exercise equipment and boats will be controlled by the coaching staff. Rowers will adhere to rowing and equipment use policies established in the SCC Adult Application & Guidelines. Boat/Facility maintenance fees will be deposited in the Boathouse Operations Account. Annual Membership fees will be deposited in the Adult Program account.

Young Adult Member Fees:

\$50 Annual Boat/Facility Maintenance Fee.

\$100 Annual Membership Fee. \$50 Six Month Membership Fee.

\$100 for each additional family member.

Personal boat storage fees will be 50% of the Associate Member rate.

SCC Adult Member: Age 27 and above. Rowing members in this category will be classified as novice or experienced. Novice and experienced rowers will adhere to rowing and equipment use policies established in the SCC Adult Application & Guidelines. Each SCC Adult member will be required to perform 18 volunteer service hours. Boat/Facility maintenance fees will be deposited in the Boathouse Operations Account. Annual Membership fees will be deposited in the Adult Program account.

SCC Adult Member Fees:

\$50 Annual Boat/Facility Maintenance Fee.

\$100 Annual Membership Fee. \$50 Six Month Membership Fee.

\$100 for each additional family member.

Personal boat storage fees will be 50% of the Associate Member rate.

\$10 per hour for service hours not performed.

Coxswains: Coxswain membership is available for individuals in recognition of the contribution that coxing affords club members. For coxswain members, boat/facility maintenance and annual membership fees are waived. Coxswains must be willing to be identified as such and be available on a reasonable basis. Coxswain members may row on an occasional basis. Membership in this category must be approved by the coaching staff and SCC Board of Directors.

Associate Member: This level of membership is for members seeking personal boat storage only. An annual membership fee will be based on the type of boat being stored at the boathouse. Associate Members will be permitted access to the boathouse during published operating hours. The membership fee will help defray the cost of operating the boathouse. Fees will be deposited into the boathouse operating fund.

Short Term Associate Member Boathouse Storage Fee:

Subject to availability, visiting rowing teams may be provided short-term storage space on boat trees outside of the boathouse for rowing shells. An "Associate Member Boat Storage and Indemnification Agreement" will be executed for the requested storage period. A storage fee of \$10 per day/per boat will entitle visiting teams to only outside boat tree space
